

Moss Hall Junior School
Parent and Carer Survey Autumn 2022

136 responses pertaining to Moss Hall Junior School

This term we created a survey based on your feedback from last year. This year’s survey enabled parents and carers to indicate which school in the federation their child was in and also if you had a child in both schools.

Overall 336 responses were gathered. The survey remained open until 25.11.22.

Of these responses:

Moss Hall Infant School - 139 responses (of 352 pupils)

Moss Hall Junior School - 136 responses (of 439 pupils)

Children at both schools - 61 responses.

Thank you for your helpful comments which we do take into account when we are planning. Positive comments in particular inspire staff and remind them that we are working together for our children.

Your comments to us ranged from practical suggestions and ideas regarding the premises to recognising the care that staff give to all our children.

“ I loved seeing the school during the academic day, seeing all the wonderful art etc on the walls. I wish there were more opportunities to see the school and attend more events.”

“ The school has made so many improvements over the last couple of years. I'm really impressed by how school staff listen and act on feedback about any issues my child is having. There is such genuine care towards my child and staff are open and approachable.”

Inevitably for some families there is too much communication and for some there is not enough about children’s learning. We understand that families are busy but you have told us you know who to talk to if you have a query. We encourage parents to book in chats with teachers if you feel you want more information about your child’s progress.

Some parents have told us that they don’t know if children behave well at Moss Hall. This tells us we have more to do to point to the positive feedback we get from visitors and from children themselves about how safe they feel and how supported they feel by the adults around them. Good manners and how to have excellent learning and social behaviour is taught explicitly in our school, which is a calm and safe environment for children.

In terms of what we may do better, we will continue to find ways to share your children’s progress journey with you. You have asked for more regular updates on children’s progress in tests. This is not something we currently do as quizzes and tests form part of our “responsive teaching” and formative assessment process.
