## Esol Classes

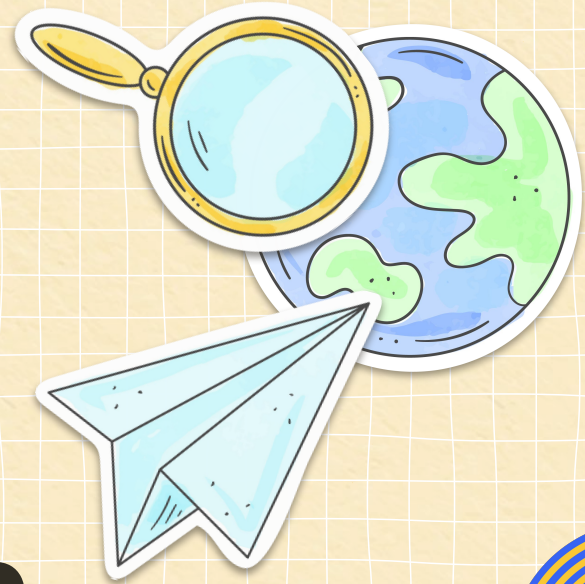
