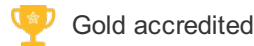

Moss hall Junior School is located between Nether Street, Moss Hall Grove and Essex park , sharing as site with Moss Hall Nursery and Infant Schools and adjacent to Alma School. Moss Hall Junior School was built in 1952 and

comprises a hall, dining room, kitchen, staff room, offices, 13 classrooms, music room, ICT Suite, swimming pool, library and other smaller teaching spaces. The building is on 3 floors; the lower floor incorporating the offices, staff room, dining room and kitchen; the middle floor (accessible via a ramp and wheelchair lift) which houses 9 of the classrooms and the top floor (accessible using a wheelchair lift) with 3 classrooms and the library. There are a number of outside areas the main one being two large playgrounds and two fields at the front of the school. Moss Hall Junior School have three entrances: Moss Hall Grove and Nether Street. The main entrance is on Nether Street which leads onto a long driveway. This driveway is accessed by delivery vehicles and staff in the kitchens. There is also a pedestrian exit onto Essex Park. There is a staff car park at the end of this driveway. The other entrance is on Moss Hall Grove. This runs parallel to the infant playground and has limited access.

Rules relating to school travel

Children at Moss Hall Junior School can travel to and from school alone. In order to do this, they need a "Lone Traveller" form specifying details and signed by their parent/guardian. Some children meet their parents at the school gates or at the Infant school. Parents must let staff know if this arrangement applies to their children.
